There is famous saying in English, “*It is not your fault if you were born poor, however it is entirely your fault if you died poor.*” The intent behind this line is that we don't have much control over our birth. However, when the Lord gave us this life, He gave us an opportunity to do good deeds and to live a great life on this planet. The harsh truth of life is that we all want to live a happy and contended life, yet very few of us are blessed to live a life which can be called as an ideal life.

Who doesn't wish to live a life full of luxuries? Who doesn't want to get what all they can think of? Who doesn't want to live in a big house or to wear expensive clothes or to drive luxurious cars or to eat what one wants to eat? However, for all these things we need money. As Tulsidas has rightly said, "*Sakal Padarath Hai Jag Mahi, Karam Heen Nar Pavat Nahi*", i.e. **all that exists in the world can be easily obtained in life, however, a man who doesn't do the right karma in life can't get them.** It is thus entirely in our hands that we want to live a life that is full of wealth, health, blessings, fortunes or to continue to suffer throughout the life and die poor.
